The background:

The Community Fund was born in the springtime of 2009, and it is anticipated that the first grant(s) or sponsorship(s) will be awarded in the New Year. Thereafter, it is hoped that the Fund will be awarded 4 times each year.

What we do:

Bedruthan is one of the UK's most environmentally friendly hotels, and we have won a variety of awards and accolades for our efforts in actively minimising our negative impacts on our surrounding environment. We also try our hardest to ensure that the financial benefits of the tourism industry reach our wider community by purchasing the vast majority of our produce, products and services from within Cornwall, and by supporting a number of Cornish charities, including the Cornwall Wildlife Trust and Surfers Against Sewage.

We also provide a haven, free of charge, for a number of disadvantaged groups from within Cornwall; groups, and their carers or leaders, are invited to spend time enjoying the hotel's facilities and resources, i.e. swimming pool, jungle tumble play area, outdoor play equipment, or even have an activity session with our staff, e.g. storytelling and art with the children's department or surfing with our resident surf instructor.



However, as one of the largest businesses in the St-Mawgan-in-Pydar parish, we are keen to make a difference to the quality of life in the immediate area by providing funding for local community groups and initiatives. While not presently a charity, The Community Fund has been set up in accordance with UK charity regulations and guidelines in anticipation that once it has made and donated over £5000, in any one year, we would be able to apply for charitable status.



The Community Fund provides a positive link between the hotel and the local community by providing guests with the opportunity to give something back.
